## Where Do I Recycle?

- ◆ **Precinct #2 Barn on Highway 77** South accepts items for recycle between the hours of 7:30 a.m. until 4:00 p.m. Monday thru Friday with the exception of holidays and on the second Saturday of the month from 9:00 a.m. until noon.
- ◆ **Precinct #3 Lexington Recycle Center at 4<sup>th</sup> and Belton Street in Lexington**, open 24 hours per day, 7 days per week. Precinct 3 holds a second Saturday cleanup each month where the Center is manned and used motor oil is accepted as well as old appliances, furniture and household discards bagged, (*these items are only excepted second Saturday*).
- ◆ **Precinct #4 Barn in Lincoln** (24 hours per day/7 days per week)
- ◆ **Dime Box Recycle Center** (24 hours per day/7 days per week) Oil recycling is taken at Alvin's Service Center.

## How Do I Recycle?

### **GLASS BOTTLES AND JARS:**

- Remove food residue
- Remove metal lids and place with tin cans
- Remove plastic lids
- Clear, brown or green glass
- No pyrex, window or plate glass

### **ALUMINUM AND TIN CANS:**

- Remove food residue
- No aerosol cans

### **MAGAZINES, NEWSPAPERS AND ALL INSERTS:**

- Must not be exposed to sun or water
- Cannot be tied in stacks
- No telephone books

### **MOTOR OIL AND OIL FILTERS:**

- No contaminants (water, etc.)
- No fiberglass filters

*No tires, batteries, tin, wire, or building materials will be accepted at any location.*
