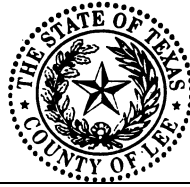

*DSHS issues reports to counties that identify COVID-19 infected individuals as "expired" or "recovered". The "expired" classification includes individuals who tested positive for COVID-19 and subsequently died. DSHS makes **no** determination that COVID-19 caused or did not cause the death.

*Includes Texas Department of Criminal Justice (TDCJ) facilities staff (if Lee county resident) and excludes TDCJ offenders.

*TDCJ cases – offenders are reported on the TDCJ website.

Governor Greg Abbott has issued [Executive Order 29](#) requiring all Texans to wear a face covering over the nose and mouth in public spaces, with few exceptions, in counties with 20 or more positive COVID-19 cases. Open [Texas checklists](#) are now updated consistent with this order.

The Governor also issued a [proclamation](#) giving mayors and county judges the ability to impose restrictions on some outdoor gatherings of over 10.
