

**LEE COUNTY, TEXAS
RESCINDING THE ORDER PROHIBITING OUTDOOR
BURNING**


WHEREAS, Section 325.081 of the Local Government Code provides that the commissioners court of a county, by order, may prohibit outdoor burning in the incorporated area of the county if the commissioners court makes a finding that circumstances present in the unincorporated area create a public safety hazard that would be exacerbated by outdoor burning; and,

WHEREAS, Lee County Commissioners authorize the County Judge to determine that circumstances present in the unincorporated areas of Lee County no longer create a public safety hazard that would be exacerbated by outdoor burning.

BE IT THEREFORE ORDERED that the Order Prohibiting Outdoor Burning for portions of the unincorporated areas of Lee County, Texas dated November 9, 2020 be rescinded **effective on January 2, 2021 at 8:00 a.m.**, and that the following be observed:

- a) **NO BURNING** if winds are 5 miles per hour or more.
- b) Use extreme caution when burning.
