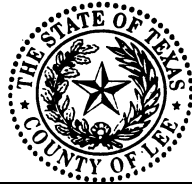

At this time, Lee County has not ordered “Shelter In Place” for Lee County residents. Some Texas counties have ordered “Shelter In Place” for its residents which prohibits and restricts activities outside of a person’s home during the duration of the disaster declaration.

Lee County is closely monitoring the outbreak of the Coronavirus and will continue to work with the Local County Health Official and State Authorities on the matter. Residents are strongly encouraged to not leave your home unless it is essential.

“Shelter In Place” sets regulations for all individuals living in the county to shelter at their place of residence except that they may leave to provide or receive certain essential services or engage in certain essential activities and work for essential businesses and governmental services; directing all businesses and governmental agencies to cease non-essential operations at physical locations in the county; prohibiting all non-essential gatherings of any number of individuals; and ordering non-essential travel to end.

As of March 25, 2020, twelve (12) test have been administered for the detection of COVID-19 infection. Nine (9) returned negative results and three (3) test are pending results.
