

**LEE COUNTY, TEXAS  
RESCINDING THE ORDER PROHIBITING OUTDOOR  
BURNING**

**WHEREAS**, Section 325.081 of the Local Government Code provides that the commissioners court of a county, by order, may prohibit outdoor burning in the incorporated area of the county if the commissioners court makes a finding that circumstances present in the unincorporated area create a public safety hazard that would be exacerbated by outdoor burning; and,

**WHEREAS**, Lee County Commissioners authorize the County Judge to determine that circumstances present in the unincorporated areas of Lee County no longer create a public safety hazard that would be exacerbated by outdoor burning.

**BE IT THEREFORE ORDERED** that the Order Prohibiting Outdoor Burning for portions of the unincorporated areas of Lee County, Texas dated February 15, 2022 be rescinded **effective on February 28, 2022 at 12 p.m.**, and that the following be observed:
